Dear Elder Scott:

Governor Pete Wilson's legislative assistant called yesterday and offered to fly Lynn Wardle to Sacramento to testify before a committee in support of A.B. 911 (HLM non-recognition). The assistant felt the vote would be close and Brother Wardle's testimony would make a difference.

The same Bill came up last session and Lynn Wardle was invited to Sacramento, but not until after the session was over. There were a number of technical questions that he would have been able to answer.

Unfortunately, the committee is made up of three Republicans and six Democrats. The Republicans support our position on this issue and the Democrats generally do not. However, possible swing votes are O'Connell and Calderon.

Bill Campbell tells me that the chances of this Bill being reported out are probably not good. However, since they have offered to pay Brother Wardle's way and since for the record, he can make some important input, we will give our approval unless you feel that this would be inappropriate.
